Title One is a federally funded program that assist at risk and poverty level students to achieve success, as we bridge the gap between low-income students and other students. The U.S. Department of Education provides supplemental funding to our local school district to assist in meeting the needs of at-risk and low-income students. \_\_\_\_\_ is considered a title one school due to our free/reduced status of our families.
